17 <i>Liatris spicata</i>	Gayfeather, Blazing star
18 <i>Penstemon</i> 'Dark Towers'	Beardtongue
19 <i>Symphotrichum novae-angliae</i>	New England aster
20 <i>Tithonia rotundifolia</i> *	Mexican sunflower
21 <i>Parthenium integrifolium</i>	Wild quinine
22 <i>Zinnia angustifolia</i> 'Summer Solstice' *	Mexican zinnia, narrowleaf zinnia
23 <i>Zinnia elegans</i> 'Benary's', 'Cactus Flowered'* 'California Giant', 'Oklahoma',* 'Purple Prince', 'Pinwheel' *	Zinnia, powdery mildew resistant cultivars
24 <i>Zizia aurea</i>	Golden alexanders
